

DBD Delight

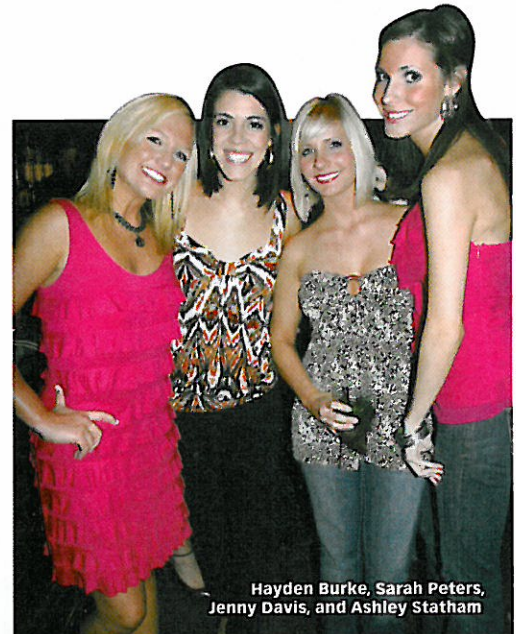

Cause for Cheers

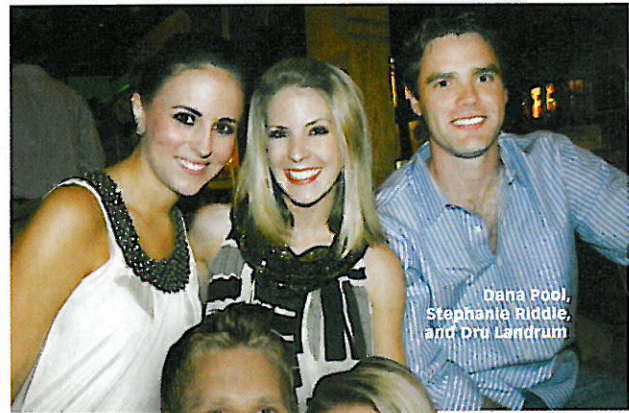
